Proposal Content	Artworks and performances to be presented during the 10th Echigo-Tsumari Art Triennale. (The Exhibition period is not yet determined). The chosen artworks are expected to highlight the unique history and culture of Echigo-Tsumari region and feature distinctive and abundant nature that has the power to raise awareness of Echigo-Tsumari internationally.  *The 10th Echigo-Tsumari Art Triennale is scheduled to be held in 2027 (date to be determined).

	Please submit a proposal for an artwork or performance to be developed at the Echigo-Tsumari Art Triennale, specifying the location where you wish it to be realized.

Evaluation Criteria	①Understanding the philosophy of the Echigo-Tsumari Art Triennale and the ability to present works/projects that are open to the local community.  * References: Catalogues from previous ETAT, "Art Place Japan: The Echigo-Tsumari Art Triennale and the vision to Reconnect Art and Nature" (Princeton Architectural Press) and "Akeyama Arts Center" (Gedndai Kikakushitsu).  ②Participation in the site visit tour, or viewing the video (a summary of the site visit tour for applicants, to be released after Friday, 19 September).

### Required Documents

- 1. **Application Form**: Please attach to the first page.
- 2. **Artwork Proposal**: Must include the following items and be compiled into a total of no more than 10 pages, including text, photographs, and images. In the selection process, emphasis will be placed on plans that align with the philosophy of the Triennale. In particular, it is recommended to clearly describe the concept, provide concrete details of the plan, and specify the production methods.
  - Title of the work
  - Proposed site(s) / project site(s) / performance venue(s) (with reasons if applicable)
  - Description of the work (concept, method, materials, dimensions) within 600 words
  - Production schedule \*Please specify desired length and number of stays
  - Budget plan
    - \* Estimate the actual production costs required for creating the work (excluding artist fees). For projects that generate income, please also submit a income and expenditure plan.
  - Reference materials such as drawings, model photographs,
     sketches, diagrams, etc. If submitting video, please limit to within 3 minutes.
  - Examples of reference works and documentation of past works

Regulations and Conditions	<ul> <li>Number of submissions: Up to three proposals per applicant/group</li> <li>Artwork conditions: No specific restrictions on size, material, or weight</li> <li>Installation environment: In principle, works must be restored to their original condition upon removal. If installed in a functioning space, its function must be maintained.</li> <li>Installation period: In principle, works must remain in good condition for at least four months. For performances, at least one performance day during the exhibition period, or multiple days/performances.</li> </ul>
Awards	<ul> <li>Participation in the 10th edition of the Echigo-Tsumari Art Triennale</li> <li>Production cost subsidy (approximately 500,000–2,500,000 JPY)</li> </ul>
