In the second half, Ondekoza, a Japanese drumming group with deep connections to the art festival, will join in and reenact the "Bon Odori" that Ryōkan loved to dance with the people. Let's dance together at the end.

[precautions]


- · You don't necessarily get on the same bus you boarded. No luggage may be left on the bus during the event.
