




Access to Echigo-Tsumari

Nakasato Area



This area is located in the southeastern part of Echigo-Tsumari. Starting around Echigo-Tazawa Station on the JR Iiyama Line, the Nakasato Area is dotted with various business establishments and bases along the Kiyotsu River, a tributary of the Shinano River. It is one of the most nature-rich areas in Niigata Prefecture, with many parks, hot springs, and campgrounds. There are many places to visit, including the works around Mion Nakasato, the Kiyotsu Gorge Tunnel, and the Kiyotsu Soko Museum of Art [SoKo], which houses the artworks of Isobe Yukihsa, the artist who proposed the fundamental idea of the ETAT.

Tsunan Area



The Tsunan area is located in the southwest and extends to the border with Nagano Prefecture. Ruins from the Jomon period can be found throughout the town, suggesting that people have been living and building their culture on the river terraces since prehistoric times. Along the Shinano River, there is the Echigo-Tsumari "Kamigo Clove Theatre" for performing arts and the Hong Kong House, a facility where international exchanges are frequent and resident artists can work. The south side of the Nakatsu River leads to Akiyama-go, one of the best-kept secrets in Japan. At the new facility, Akeyama Arts Center, artists learn about the techniques and wisdom passed down in Akiyama-go and try to create groups of reproduced artworks in new forms.
